### A FEW BIG IDEAS FROM THE TEACHING

---

The word “gospel” means good news or good announcement.

The gospel of the kingdom begins with good news of our loving father & powerful king.

The gospel has the power to **save** us. (Romans 1:16)

The gospel has the power to **sanctify** us. (John 17:17)

The gospel has the power to **strengthen** us. (Romans 16:25)

The gospel has the power to **send** us out. (Luke 10:9–10)

The gospel is an announcement that we must receive, respond to in faithful obedience, and then re-tell ourselves & others as often as possible.

As you fix your heart on Jesus, ask him to help you believe the truth of this good news deep in your heart.

Where do you find it difficult to receive the Father’s love in your life?

Where do you sense the Father is inviting you to respond to this message of love?
