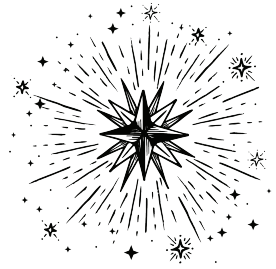

## *A promised* FAMILY

---

### A FEW BIG IDEAS FROM THE TEACHING

---

God's covenant with Abraham included 3 specific promises:

1. A Specific **Land**

Genesis 12:1; Genesis 12:7; Genesis 13:15; Genesis 15:18

2. A Multitude of **Offspring**

Genesis 12:2; Genesis 12:7; Genesis 13:16; Genesis 15:5

The word “offspring” in the above verses is the same Hebrew word that God used in the “Hope-Filled Promise” from Genesis 3:15 when He said that one of Eve’s offspring would crush the serpent.

3. A Global **Blessing**

Connecting the Gospel to Abraham

Galatians 3:8 tells us that the “gospel” was announced to Abraham.

3 Takeaways:

1. God's **Faithfulness** — when God makes a promise he can be trusted.
2. God's **Power** — God alone will carry out & complete the gospel.
3. God's **Glory** — This story is not about us, but about God's glory.

---

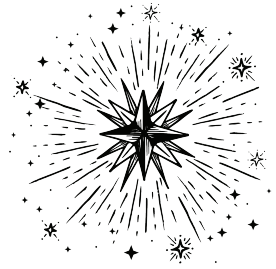
Why is it important that we see the broader story of the gospel and our place in it?
